- vi. List of cases disposed of under section 265-K or 249-A Cr.PC.
- vii. Number of bail applications pending for more than one month and the reasons for such delay.
- viii. Number of petitions u/s 22-A Cr.PC pending for more than one month and reasons for such delay.
- ix. Number of applications u/s 491 Cr.PC pending for more than one month and reasons for such delay.
- x. Number of applications u/s 516-A Cr.PC pending for more than one month and reasons for such delay.

- xii. Number of cases disposed of under Order-VII, Rule-11 CPC.
- xiii. Number of cases in which written statement filed, but issues not framed.

- xv. Number of cases in which arguments heard, but judgment not announced.
- xvi. Number of cases in which judgment announced, but file not consigned to record or sent to Copyist.
